Step 1 – “Zone Team Tryout Camps”

- Phoenix, March 4 – ASU Mona Plummer Pool, Noon-6:30 PM
- Salt Lake – March 9, 6:30-9:30 PM, and March 10, 8:00 AM-2:00 PM, Girls at Kearns, Boys at Cottonwood HS.
- Reno – March 1 and 8, 7:00-10:00 PM.
- Denver – March 17 – Hinckley HS, 7:00-4:00.
- Las Vegas – March 6 and 9 – Henderson Multi-Gen. Pool, 6:30-9:00 PM.
- Albuquerque – March 24 – Highland Pool, 7:00-Noon.
- Cost is \$20 per person.

Step 2 - “Zone Team Training Camps”

- 18-22 athletes will be selected from the six Step 1 Camps to be on each Zone Team.
 - Girls Youth – Las Vegas, April 13-15.
 - Girls Cadet – Tempe, May 4-6.
 - Boys Youth – Kearns, April 20-22.
 - Boys Cadet – Salt Lake, April 20-22.
- Each athlete will receive a Mountain Zone Team T-Shirt.
- Cost is \$30 per person paid to the zone.

Step 3 – “Zone Traveling Team – National Camps”

- 12-14 athletes will be selected from each Step 2 Camp to be on the Zone Traveling Squad for each category to attend the National Zone Championship Tournament.
- Memorial Day weekend, May 26-29 – arrive Sat. morning, depart Tues. afternoon.
 - Girls Youth – Kearns, Utah.
 - Girls Cadet – Seattle, Washington.
 - Boys Youth – S.F. Bay Area, California.
 - Boys Cadet – Mission Viejo, California.
- Cost is \$235 per person payable to the zone. Helps cover camp fee, hotel, ground transportation, and a zone team suit. Airfare (or travel) and food paid by athletes.
