

Skyline Girls, Kearns Boys win Utah High School JV State Championships

8 girls teams and 11 boys teams entered this year's JV State. 41 games were played May 6-8, both at Park City and Kearns, with the final round games being played at Park City. The teams were divided into pools and the first and second place team from each pool played a cross over game to determine 1st through 4th place.
